This week at Hardwick...

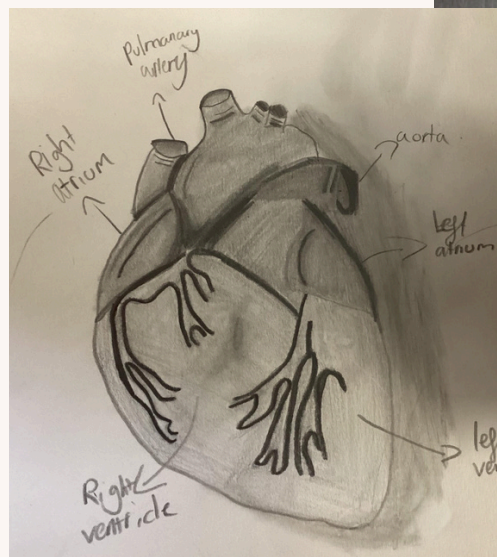
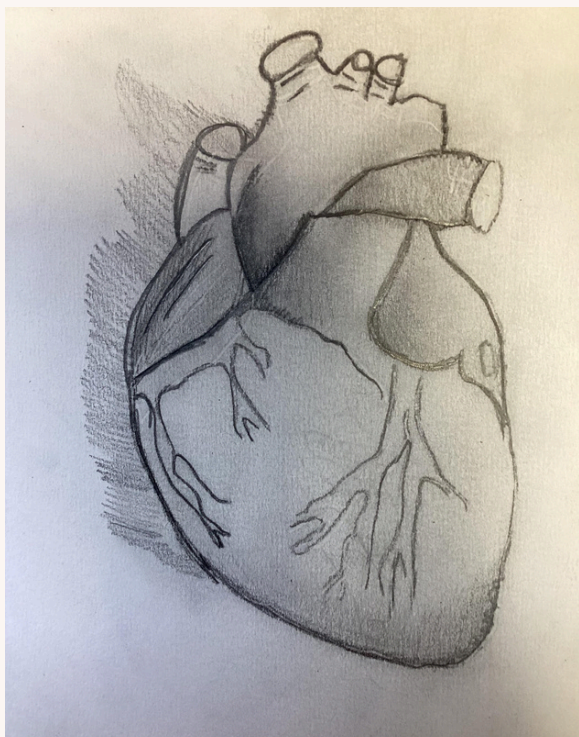
In Rabbit Class, the children continue to explore their classroom environments with curiosity, and it has been wonderful to see their friendships blossoming and their growing teamwork.



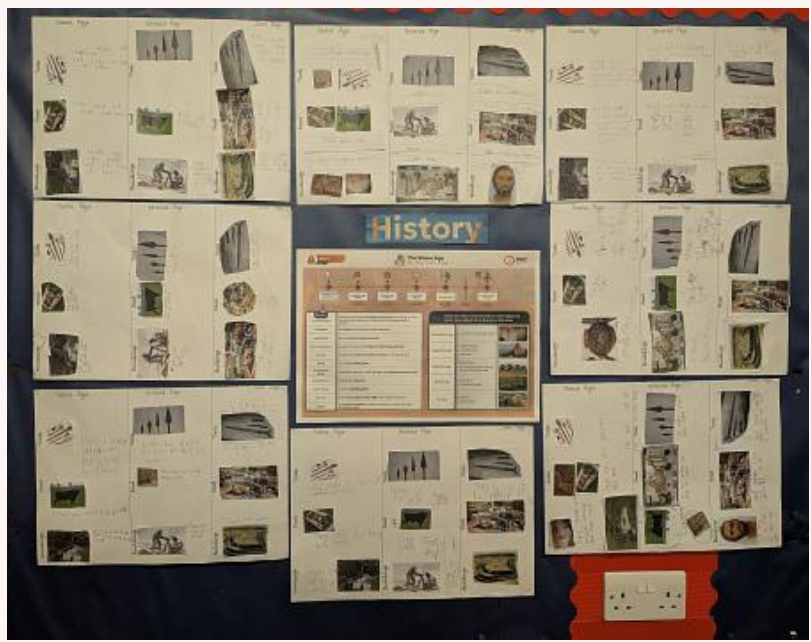
