## Tourette's Awareness

This week, we have been raising awareness of Tourette's Syndrome and helping the children develop a better understanding of the condition. We began with a whole-school assembly where pupils learnt that Tourette's involves tics, which are movements or sounds that a person cannot stop.

The children took part in an activity where they tried not to blink to help them understand what this might feel like, and learnt that only a small number of people with Tourette's develop a swearing tic. In class assemblies, pupils further developed their understanding by taking part in a true or false quiz. It has been a valuable week promoting empathy and understanding across the school.
