

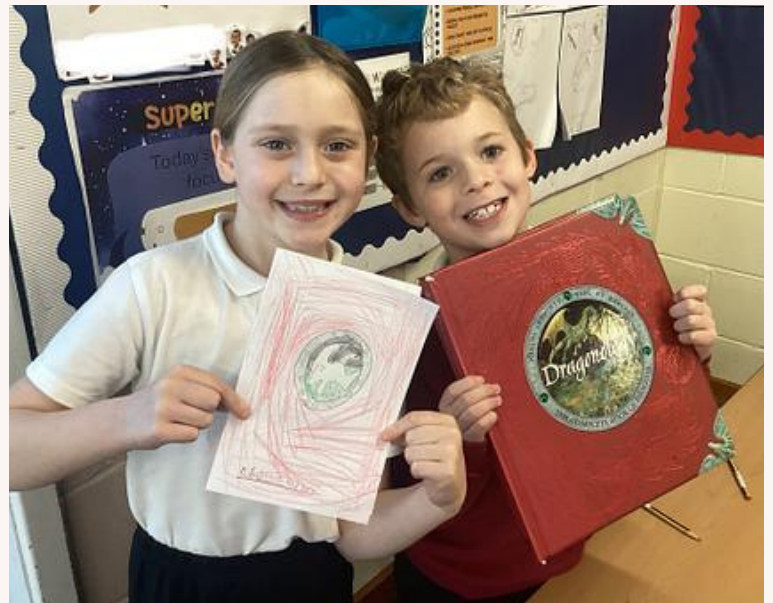
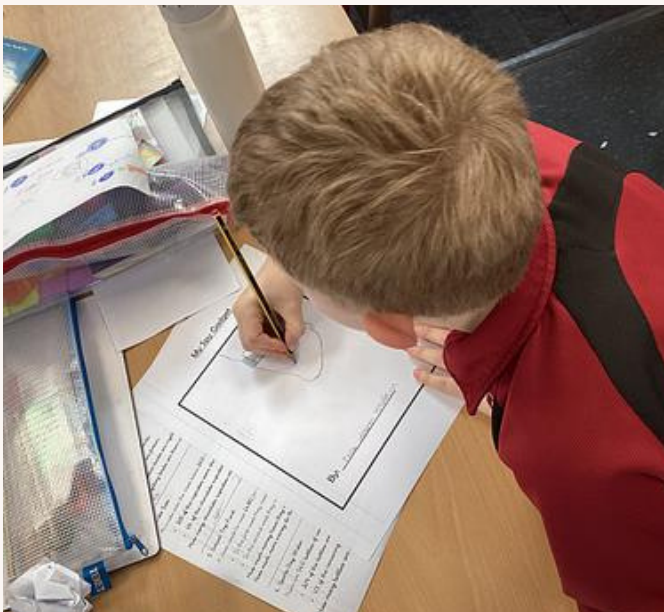

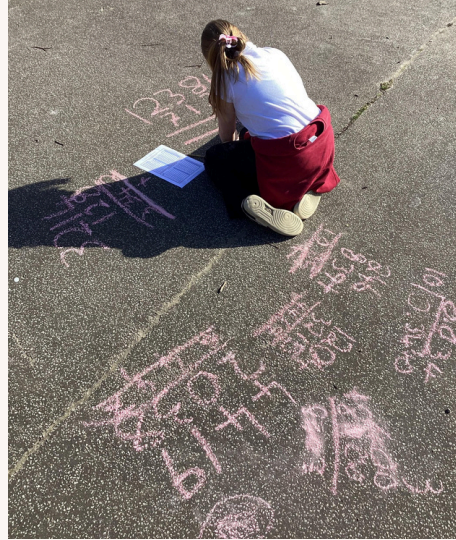
It was truly a day filled with imagination, creativity and a shared love of reading.
